1967

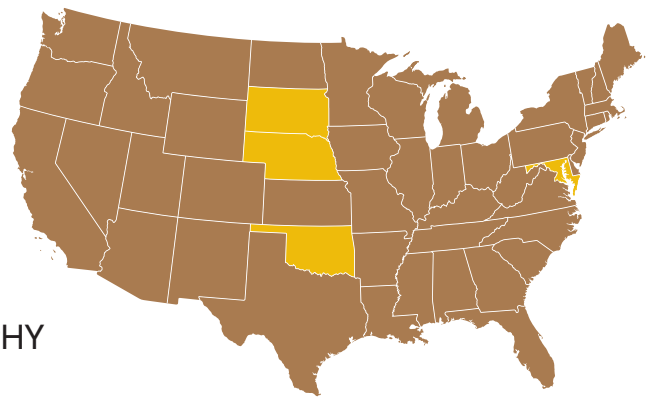
Obviously, a lot has changed since then, especially shifts in Oklahoma's population distribution. But judicial boundaries for the highest courts haven't kept pace with the times.

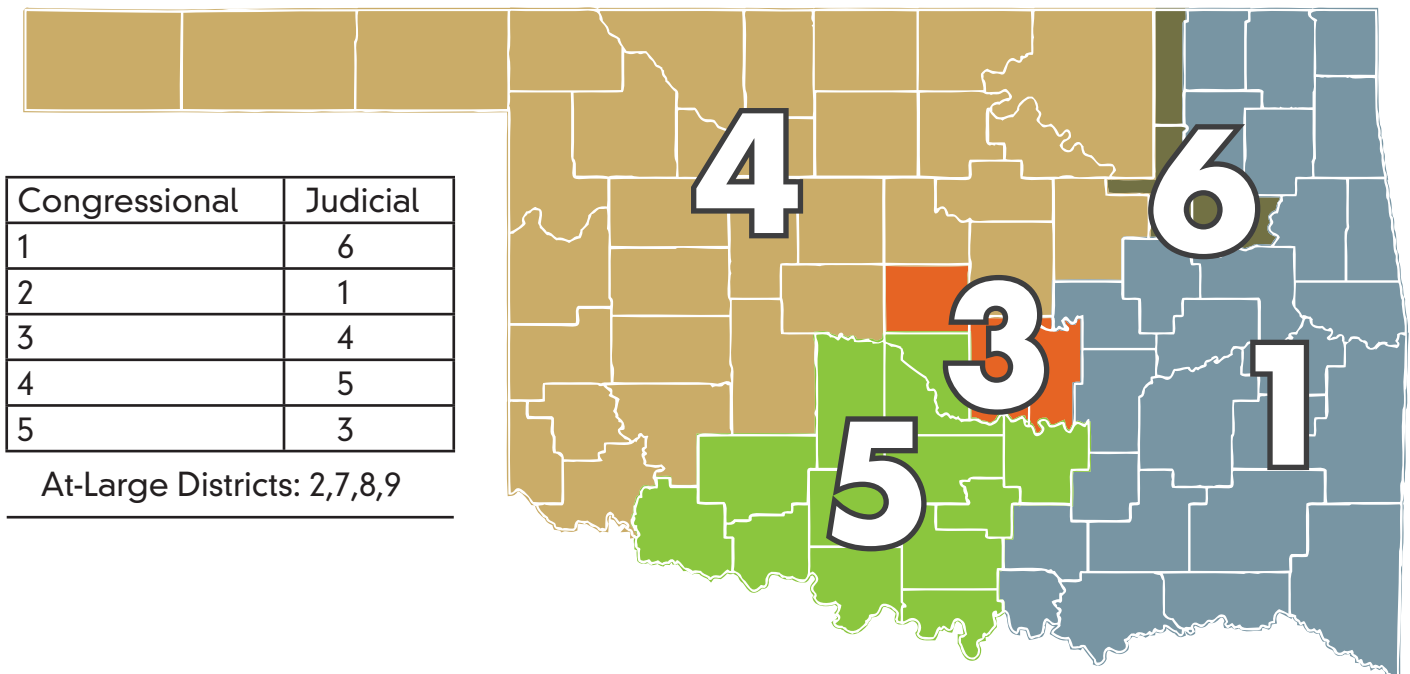
